Note

The National Olympic Memorial Youth Center is NOT A HOTEL. It is a public dormitory. Therefore, there are no amenities and services a normal accommodation would have. All participants are required to conform to the following instructions:

- Do not eat in the meeting rooms.
- Do not leave behind any garbage

For Students

- Each student will stay in a private room.
- Each student will generally use a public bath. (Students with special reasons may use the private bath but would need prior permission and would be limited.)
- Each student will use shared restrooms.
- The rooms should be cleaned and put back to normal in addition to putting back the used linen items to the designated area when leaving on February 29th.
- Since there are no amenities, students are encouraged to bring their own towels, shampoos, soaps, hair dryers, medicine and so on.
- There are laundromats if needed.
- Eating and drinking alcohol in the room are prohibited.

For Professors

- Each professor will stay in a private room.
- The rooms are Western style with a bed.
- There is a private bath and a toilet in each room.
- Towels will be changed every day and linen items once in two days.
- There is free Wi-Fi available in the room.

About the public baths

The public baths are separate for men and women. In each public bath, there are two or three showers and a large bathtub. Basically, we ask all students to use the public baths. For people who have strong

reluctance or religious restraints to use the public baths, we will organize the use of private baths. However, since the number of private baths is limited, we will ask you to follow a strict schedule of when and how long you can use the bath. We will ask each student if they wish to use the private shower in the course of the application procedure. Thank you for your understanding.
